

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
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## Behavioral Heath Outpatient Utilization per 1,000 Members






## Substance Use Outpatient Utilization per 1,000 Members




## Substance Use Outpatient Total Utilization by Age






### Behavioral Heath Hospitalization Utilization per 1,000 Members by Age

Claims Decreased	54,288	(26.3%)
<b>Utilizers Decreased</b>	18,372	<b>!</b> (27.1%)

MAT Scripts Increased	2,100	<b>1</b> 34%
Rescue Therapy Scripts Increased*	1,646	985%
