Executive Summary

This information consent item includes our annual report to the committee regarding the status of participating employers. The annual report provides an update on the contract program, collection activities, and terminations in process.

Strategic Plan

This agenda item supports fund sustainability and risk management goals of the CalPERS 2017-2022 Strategic Plan, which aims to strengthen the long-term sustainability of the pension fund. Pension and health funding are considered a strategic risk to the organization, and proper management of employer contracts and collection of payments are critical to ensuring long-term sustainability.

Background

In September 2020, the FAC received their first annual program update regarding the status of participating employers. The presentation provided information on the contract program, contract terminations in process, and participating employers experiencing hardship.
