(The Trustee is pursuing additional claims that could increase the amount owed by YAAF I. YAAF I has appealed the decision leading to the outstanding judgment.) The Trustee asserts that YAAF I should not have transferred assets to the investors in light of the Trustee's litigation against YAAF I, and seeks to recover directly from the investors (including CalPERS)
