

**PROPOSED REGULATIONS DESIGNATING SPECIFIC PAYMENT DATES
FOR STATE OF CALIFORNIA EMPLOYER AND EMPLOYEE RETIREMENT
CONTRIBUTIONS**

California Code of Regulations, Title 2, Article 5.5, 577 and 578

Chapter 2. Board of Administration of Public Employees' Retirement System
Subchapter 1. Employees' Retirement System Regulations
Article 5.5 State Employer Contributions

ADOPT Section 577

577. The member portion of retirement contributions for State of California employees shall be paid to the Public Employees Retirement System on or before the first business day after the last day of the pay period to which they refer.

ADOPT Section 578

578. The State of California employer portion of retirement contributions due to the Public Employees Retirement Fund shall be paid to the Fund on the dates specified:

1. For payroll periods ending in the months of July, August and September payment of contributions due shall be made to the System no later than the first business day in October.
2. For payroll periods ending in the months of October and November payment of contributions due shall be made to the System no later than December 17 or the prior business day if December 17 is a weekend or State holiday.
3. For the payroll period ending in the month of December payment of contributions due shall be made to the System no later than the first business day in January.
4. For payroll periods ending in the months of January and February payment of contributions due shall be made to the System no later than April 16 or the next business day if April 16 is a weekend or State holiday.
5. For the payroll period ending in the month of March payment of contributions due shall be made to the System no later than the first business day in April.
6. For payroll periods ending in the months of April, May and June payment of contributions due shall be made to the System no later than the first business day in July.
