The Bankruptcy Court has not yet ruled on the City's eligibility to file for bankruptcy relief and no order for relief has yet been entered. The City has not yet filed a plan of adjustment. Certain creditors have objected to the City's eligibility on various grounds. Discovery has been served against CalPERS in connection with the contested eligibility matter.</p>
