Issues/Status:	Ms. Okwu has been unsuccessfully litigating CalPERS' denial of her request for reinstatement from disability retirement in both state and federal court for several years. This case is the third court case to be filed arising from the same set of circumstances. The Complaint alleges violations of the Americans with Disabilities Act and the California Fair Employment and Housing Act. In addition, the Complaint alleges violations of the First, Fifth and Fourteenth Amendments to the U. S. Constitution. A responsive pleading is due from CalPERS by December 15, 2012.
