

Legislative History

- 2011 Chapter 25 (SB 151, Correa) – Ratified the provisions of the memoranda of understanding between the State and Bargaining Units 2, 6, 7, 9, 10, and 13, and ratified numerous addenda to agreements ratified in 2010. Among its provisions, this bill ended the State employer’s contributions to the Peace Officers and Firefighters Defined Contribution Plan. *CalPERS Position: None taken.*
- 2007 Chapter 511 (AB 1307, Krekorian) – Revised and updated the Supplemental Contribution Plan (SCP), including expanding eligibility for SCP participation and authorizing the CalPERS Board to permit in-service withdrawals. *CalPERS Position: Sponsor.*
- 1999 Chapter 307 (SB 522, Wright) – Deleted the SCP provisions and added new plan provisions to separate part of the Government Code to ensure the plan would operate as a separate tax-qualified defined contribution plan pursuant to Internal Revenue Code (IRC) section 401(a). In addition, the bill provided for frequent valuations and crediting of earnings to participant accounts, as well as the structure necessary to improve customer service. *CalPERS’ Position: Sponsor.*
- 1998 Chapter 820 (AB 2472, Leonard) – Ratified the provisions of the memorandum of understanding between the State and the California Correctional Peace Officers Association representing Bargaining Unit 6, including revising the Peace Officer and Firefighter Defined Contribution Plan. *CalPERS Position: None taken.*
- Chapter 21 (SB 615, Burton) – Ratified the provisions of the memorandum of understanding between the State and the California Correctional Peace Officers Association representing Bargaining Unit 6, including establishing the Peace Officer and Firefighter Defined Contribution Plan. *CalPERS Position: None taken.*
- 1993 Chapter 174 (AB 701, Tucker) – Permitted any eligible state member to make additional contributions to the CalPERS defined benefit plan solely at the option and expense of the member. Employer contributions were prohibited and the cost of administration had to be paid solely from the additional member contributions. *CalPERS’ Position: Neutral*
