

Dependent Eligibility Verification Project

Purpose

- The Dependent Eligibility Verification (DEV) project will help manage health care costs by ensuring that all dependents enrolled in CalPERS Health Benefits Program are eligible for coverage.

Project Approach

- Verify more than 738,000 dependents over nine cycles
- Request subscribers to submit documents substantiating eligibility for the dependents enrolled on their health plan

Project Highlights

Disenrollment activities for three cycles completed as of May 15, 2014. Highlights include:

- 251,519 dependents verified
- 6,646 ineligible dependents disenrolled
 - 5,630 from Active Members
 - 1,016 from Retirees

Note: Due to the dynamic nature of health program enrollments, disenrollment data are a point-in-time snapshot. Final statistics may vary.

Current Status & Next Steps

Three verification cycles are currently in progress.

Three other cycles will begin between now and the spring of 2015:

- Public Agency Actives August 1, 2014
- Public Agency Retirees October 1, 2014
- School District Actives & Retirees December 1, 2014
