PAHBDNA Survey Background

Survey was released on January 31, 2014 to the following stakeholder groups:

- PEMHCA Employers
- Pension-Only Employers
- Member Organizations

Survey closed on February 28, 2014.

PAHBDNA Survey Background (cont'd)

PEMHCA Employers

- 1,084 surveyed; 249 responded
- 23% response rate

Pension-Only Employers

- 609 surveyed; 85 responded
- 14% response rate

Member Organizations

- 20 surveyed; 3 responded
- 15% response rate
