December 17, 2014

The Pension & Health Benefits Committee met on December 16, 2014.

The Committee is recommending the following action items to the Board today.

### I move the Board approve the Committee's recommendation regarding:

• AGENDA ITEM 5

Approve the regulations for submission to the Office of Administrative law that make technical amendments to the plan provisions for the Public Employees' Retirement Fund, the Legislators' Retirement Fund, the Judges' Retirement Fund II, and the Supplemental Contributions Plan (individually the "Plan", and collectively "the Plans") in accordance with the Internal Revenue Service rules.  AGENDA ITEM 6 Sponsor legislation to make minor clarifying technical changes to sections of the Government Code administered by CaIPERS.
