It is validated w/ the mbr's file, that Merlayna Yee had ongoing correspondence with the Chief Deputy City Clerk at the City of Vernon re the Mbr's reportable compensation to PERS. The last correspondence to the Chief Deputy City Clerk stated "It would be logical that Mr. Malkenhorst would receive retirement benefits calculated on the position of City Administrator/City Clerk. However the other duties for the positions listed (City Treasurer, Director of Finance and Personnel, Purchasing Agent, Executive Director of Light & Power and Executive Director of the Redevelopment Agency) would be considered OVERTIME"(dated 3/13/96). Because this was an ESTIMATE ONLY, and the mbr has not submitted a Retirement Appli
