## FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The above-captioned matter, concerning the issue of disability for the performance of duties of Fire Captain for the City of San Bernardino of RICHARD LEWIS, came before TERI BAKER, Disability and Rehabilitation Hearing Officer, on October 30, 2012

The Hearing Officer examined and considered the proofs offered by the parties These proofs included an Interoffice Memorandum from Ms Rhonda Haynes, Risk Division Manager, dated October 29, 2012, and the report of Stanley Majcher, M.D., FACP, dated September 17, 2012 The Disability and Rehabilitation Hearing Officer being fully advised makes her Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law as follows

## FINDINGS

- Applicant, RICHARD LEWIS, was hired by the City of San Bernardino as a Firefighter on March 30, 1981, was later promoted to the position of Fire Captain and remained in that position until he retired on November 1, 2012
- 2 During his career, Mr Lewis sustained the following injuries 18 Necl/Disk 5/20/84 19 8/3/93 Lower Extremity 20 3/9/02 Right Shoulder Strain 21 22 6/2/04 Right Knee Pain 1/19/08 Left Leg
- 10/15/09 24 Right Knee 25 1/9/11 Left Wrist 7/6/11 Right Knee 26 7/19/11 27 Cancer 7/19/11 Knees, Hearing Loss, Right Shoulder 28

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- 4 Mr Lewis is precluded from climbing/bending, squatting/kneeling, and standing or walking for more than 15 minutes per hour
- The City of San Bernardino Human Resources Department, Risk Management Division, recommends a finding that Mr Lewis's work restrictions cause him to be a qualified injured worker and in need of vocational retraining pursuant to Labor Code section 139.5 The San Bernardino Fire Department does not have permanent modified duty status, therefore, RICHARD LEWIS could not continue his employment there given his condition. The Risk Management Division therefore has recommended RICHARD LEWIS for an industrial retirement.

## CONCLUSIONS

Based on objective evidence, I find and determine that the Applicant, RICHARD LEWIS, is incapacitated within the meaning of the Public Employees' Retirement Law for the performance of his usual duties as a Fire Captain for the City of San Bernardino Fire Department, and that he is incapacitated for performance of the usual duties of the position for other California public agencies in CalPERS. Similar positions with reasonably comparable pay, benefits, and promotional opportunities with other California public agencies are not available. Such industrial disability is a result of an injury arising out of and in the course of employment and not caused by the negligent act of a third party. As such, RICHARD LEWIS's last date of payroll was October 31, 2012 RICHARD LEWIS's effective date of said industrial retirement was November 1, 2012 DATED November 77, 2012
