Suite 1400, Glendale, CA 91203, for 1 day on November 5, 2014 at 9:00 am, upon the
charges made in the Statement of Issues served upon the respondent. If you object to

1 the place of hearing, you must notify the presiding officer within 10 days after this
2 notice is served on you. Failure to notify the presiding officer within 10 days will
3 deprive you of a change in the place of the hearing. You may contact Susan Formaker
4 or Nancy Beezy Micon (LA), Presiding Administrative Law Judges of the OAH Los
Angeles at (213) 576-7200.

5 You may be present at the hearing. You have a right to be represented by an
6 attorney at your own expense. You are not entitled to the appointment of an attorney
7 to represent you at public expense. You are entitled to represent yourself without legal
8 counsel. You may present any relevant evidence and will be given full opportunity to
9 cross-examine all witnesses testifying against you. You are expected to be ready to
10 proceed with your case at the time of hearing. Failure to appear at the hearing, either
11 through an attorney or personally, if you do not have an attorney, may result in a
12 default. This means that CalPERS' decision will be upheld irrespective of any
evidence that may or may not be introduced in your absence.

13 You have a right to an interpreter if you do not proficiently speak or understand
14 English. If you need an interpreter, you must notify CalPERS immediately so that
appropriate arrangements can be made.

15 You are entitled to the issuance of subpoenas to compel the attendance of
16 witnesses and the production of books, documents, or other things by applying to said
17 agency at: OAH Los Angeles, Office of Administrative Hearings Los Angeles, 320
