

Additional Contribution Pursuant to G.C. Section 20683.2

The table below shows the expected contribution in dollars resulting from the additional contribution required to be paid by the state, pursuant to Government Code Section 20683.2.

Note that the payroll used to calculate the expected dollar contributions is the payroll used in the valuation as of June 30, 2015 incorporating two years of payroll growth using the payroll growth assumption of 3 percent. To the extent that payroll in 2016-17 is different than the projected payroll, the actual contribution amounts will be different than the expected contributions shown in the table above.
