

Legislative History

- 1945 Chapter 123 (SB 1150, Fletcher) – Among other things, required the State to pay state employees, who had been suspended and subsequently had that suspension reversed, the salary that they would have received during the suspension.

- 1985 Chapter 1195 (AB 2009, Papan) – Among other things, required the State to reinstate the benefits that would have been accrued to a state employee who had been subject to adverse action and subsequently had that adverse action reversed, including retirement, medical, dental, and seniority benefits.
