 AGENDA ITEM 6 – Semiannual Status Reports on Performance Plans of the Chief Executive Officer and Chief Investment Officer

Approve the 2016-17 Semiannual Status Reports of the CEO and CIO, and proposed changes to the CIO's plan, as amended by the Committee and shown in Attachment 1.

Approve staff conducting a biennial salary survey for positions covered under the Board's compensation-setting authority, and bring forward an information item regarding compensation for selected positions not currently covered, at a future Committee meeting.
