Board Regulation 555 delegates the Board of Administration's authority regarding the hearings process to

the CalPERS Executive Officer and his/her subordinates. In this case, CalPERS has determined that the Los Angeles OAH is the most appropriate forum for this hearing.

You may be present at the hearing. You have the right to be represented by an attorney at your own expense. You are not entitled to the appointment of an attorney to represent you at public expense. You are also entitled to represent yourself without legal counsel. You may present any relevant evidence, and will be given full opportunity to cross-examine all witnesses testifying against you. You are entitled to the issuance of subpoenas to compel the attendance of witnesses and the production of books, documents or other things by applying to the Los Angeles Office of Administrative Hearings.
