

Finance and Administration Committee Meeting Summary

March 14-15, 2017

The Finance & Administration Committee met on March 14 & 15, 2017.

THE COMMITTEE RECOMMENDS AND I MOVE, the Board approve the following:

AGENDA ITEM 5a

Approve staff recommendation to terminate the East San Gabriel Valley Human Services Consortium contract with the California Public Employees' Retirement System. Reductions in retiree benefits be adopted as staff has recommended effective July 1 and that staff has been instructed to engage with the 4 member organizations of the Consortium to attempt to collect the past due amount. And if that were to take effect, staff would bring back to this committee a payment schedule reflecting those payments.

The Chair directed staff to...

- Bring back in April a discussion on statutory change for JPA contracting agencies.
- Bring back to the Committee an update on the termination process to include a discussion of notification to employees & retirees.

The Committee heard public comment on the following topic:
