## THE COMMITTEE RECOMMENDS AND I MOVE, the Board approve the following:

 AGENDA ITEM 3b - Revisions to Board Governance Committee Delegation and Board Governance Policy Regarding Responsibility for Creating/Disbanding Committees

Approve revisions to the Board Governance Committee Delegation and to the Board Governance Policy to reassign the responsibility for creating and disbanding committees from Board Governance Committee to the full Board of Administration.

 AGENDA ITEM 3c - Revision to Board Governance Policy Regarding Representation on Outside Boards

Approve revisions to the Board Governance Policy to add a procedure for Board members to obtain approval of their service on outside boards related to CalPERS.

 AGENDA ITEM 3d - Revision to Board Governance Policy Regarding Form 700 Transparency

Approve Form 700 transparency language which will be added to the Board Governance Policy.

• AGENDA ITEM 5 – Annual Review of CEO Delegation

Approve revisions to the CEO Delegation Resolution which includes language to clarify the CEO's delegated authority regarding Public Agency contract terminations.
