Executive Summary

Strategic Plan

This agenda item supports Goal B of the 2018-22 Strategic Plan, which is to cultivate a high-performing, risk-intelligent, and innovative organization.

Background

The last revision to the Finance & Administration Committee Delegation Resolution, approved by the Board of Administration in May 2017, added language to clarify the Committee's oversight role as it pertains to approving reimbursement to elected Board members' employers. This allowed the Committee to retire the *Policy for Approval of Reimbursement to State, School and Public Agency Employers of Elected Board Members* and incorporate the responsibility in the Board Governance Policy. The streamlined and consolidated policies that govern the Board's activities.

Analysis

Staff has reviewed the Delegation Resolution for the Finance & Administration Committee and recommends no revisions at this time. Any revisions to the Delegation Resolution that the Committee wishes to make will be incorporated and brought back for Board consideration and approval at a subsequent meeting.
