Theme	Belief
Health Program Sustainability	The long-term-sustainability of the Health Program is the foremost consideration when reviewing proposed changes to benefits, coverage areas, and costs.
High Quality Care	Health benefit designs should help improve health outcomes by maximizing high value care and reducing unwarranted care. Health benefit plan designs should improve member health outcomes, maximize quality, and reduce unwarranted care.
Affordability	Health premiums and out-of-pocket costs must be affordable for members and sustainable for employers affordable and sustainable for members and employers.
