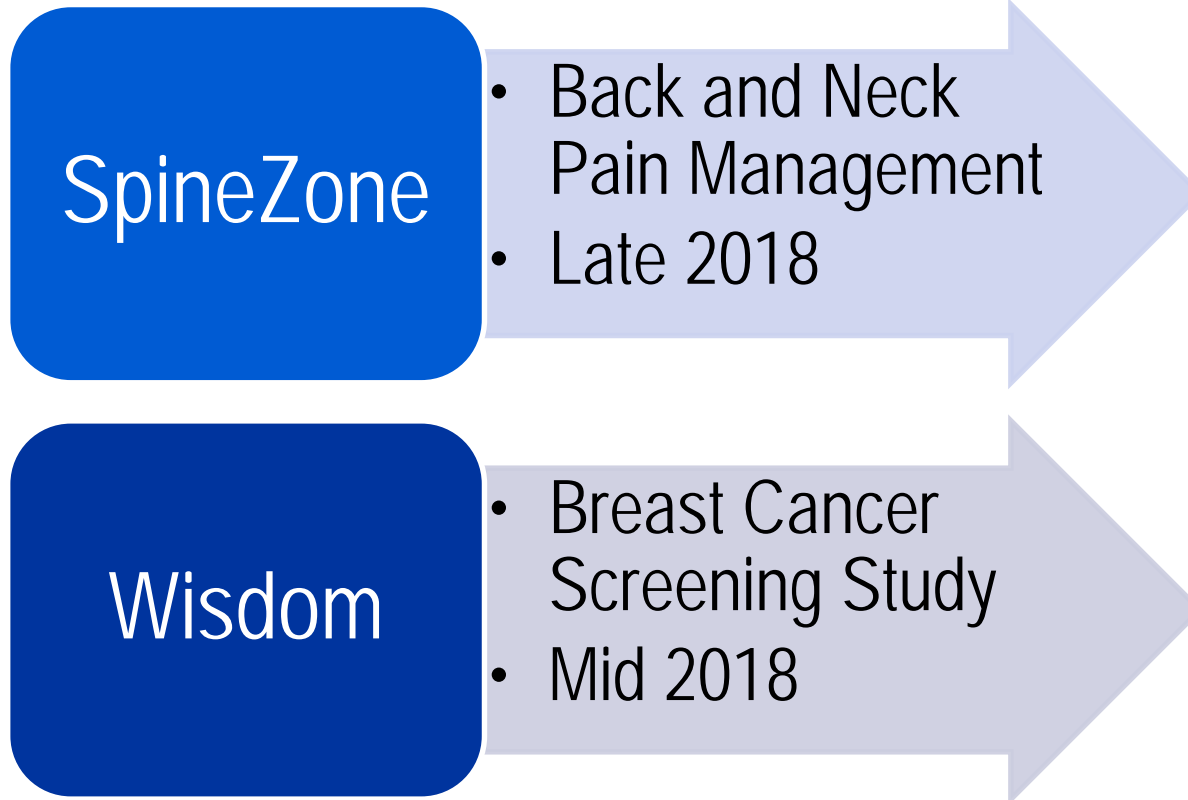

January 2018 Benefit Changes Update*

-  Ambulatory Surgery Centers – 1,759 Procedures
-  Medical Pharmacy Site of Care Management – 10 Reviews
-  Emergency Room Alternatives – 7,000 Members Informed
-  Castlight – 22% of Eligible Households Registered
-  SilverSneakers – 7,045 Enrolled

* Utilization as of January 2018 except Ambulatory Surgery Centers which is through February 2018
