The Committee received reports on the following topics:

- The Committee received an update on the options considered by the Health Plan Administration Division for administering a reference pricing program; and, the CaIPERS Evaluation of Health Regions for Public Agencies and Schools.
- The Committee previewed an online demo of the new CalPERS Open Enrollment mobile application.

The Committee directed staff to:

• Come back in November with more information on a full solicitation for the reference pricing prescription drugs by therapeutic class versus continuing with a pilot.
