Subject: CalPERS Fiscal Year 2018-19 Mid-Year Budget (First Reading)

In November, the Finance & Administration Committee (Committee) recommended the California Public Employees' Retirement System (CalPERS) Board of Administration (Board) approve a proposed Fiscal Year (FY) 2018-19 Mid-Year Budget.

The budget was accepted by the Committee as a first reading on November 13, 2018. The Board subsequently approved the budget as a first reading at the November 14, 2018 meeting. If approved by the Board as a second reading in December, this budget will become effective January 1, 2019.

In accordance with provisional budget language included in the 2018 Budget Act<sup>1</sup>, enclosed is a copy of CaIPERS' proposed FY 2018-19 Mid-Year Budget as presented to the Committee and Board.
