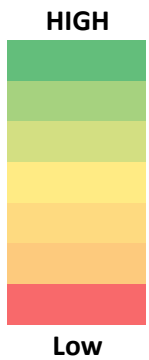

**1. Heat Index Filters:** Drug Interchangeability, Medicare Protected 6 (*anticonvulsants, antidepressants, antineoplastics, antipsychotics, antiretrovirals and immunosuppressants*), Disruption, Clinical Outcomes, Spend Reduction

**2. Index Key: Red to Green (Lowest to Highest Index)**  
 (Red to Yellow: e.g. Medicare Protected and/or Low Interchangeability, High Disruption, Unfavorable Clinical Outcomes, Low Spending Reduction Rank)  
 (Dark Green e.g. High Interchangeability, Not Medicare Protected, Low Disruption, Favorable Clinical Outcomes, High Spend Reduction Ranking)
