Item Name: Health Open Enrollment Results

**Program**: Health Benefits

**Item Type**: Information Consent

#### **Executive Summary**

This agenda item reports the migration of members between health plans, based on the results of the 2018 Open Enrollment period. In total, 94,153 (6.41 percent) of the California Public Employees' Retirement System (CalPERS) Total Covered Lives (TCLs) changed health plans. The number of members enrolled in a Health Maintenance Organization (HMO) health plan decreased by 0.34 percent, members enrolled in a Preferred Provider Organization (PPO) plan increased by 1.39 percent, and members enrolled in Association health plans decreased by 1.88 percent.

#### **Background**

Yearly, CalPERS reports the results of Open Enrollment. This year's results showed a trend of increased transfer rates compared to 2017. In 2017, the transfer rate was 4.93 percent. That rate increased to 6.41 percent in 2018.

#### **Analysis**

CalPERS measured the impact of the 2018 Open Enrollment period by comparing the number of members changing plans effective January 1, 2019, to the December 1, 2018, enrollment counts. This comparison highlights changes due to Open Enrollment.

The following charts display the top three plans that experienced the highest net gain in enrollment and the top three plans that experienced the biggest net loss. Please note that not all transfers are shown and only the top three movements are displayed.
