Executive Summary

The purpose of this agenda item is to present the Annual Consulting and Service Contract Report and the Annual Procurement Activity Report for Fiscal Year (FY) 2018-19.

Strategic Plan

This item is not a specific part of the Strategic Plan, but is part of the regular and ongoing workload of the Operations Support Services Division.

Background

The Contracts and Procurement Activity reports are presented on an annual basis to provide detailed information and fiscal year totals for both procurement and contracting activities.

Analysis

The total number of contracts had a minimal increase; however, the total contract amount for FY 2018-19 increased by approximately \$31M. While contract amounts increased in some areas and decreased in others, the increase is predominantly in investment contracts, with an increase of \$29M.

Overall, purchase orders decreased in number and cost in comparison to the previous FY. Analysis shows a decrease in purchase order quantity and amount in the areas of Consulting Services, Non-IT and State Buildings. • Annual Consulting and Service Contract Report (Attachment 1) includes detailed information on consulting and service agreements (with an amount of \$100,000 or greater) utilized during the reporting period.
