Meeting Summary

November 20, 2019

The Pension and Health Benefits Committee (PHBC) met on November 19, 2019.

The Committee received reports on the following topics:

- The Committee received an update on mental health access and treatment among CalPERS members and information on current strategies of outpatient pharmaceutical spending.
- The Committee received Public Comment regarding the Dependent Eligibility Verification program and the CalPERS Long-Term Care program.

The Chair directed staff to:

- Report back to the Committee on CalPERS membership that may have been impacted by the DMHC corrective settlement with Kaiser.
- Request Kaiser to respond to the issues that were raised during the Mental Health public comment from Kaiser's clinician and the National Union of Healthcare Workers.

At this time, I would like to share some highlights of what to expect at the December PHBC meeting:

The Committee will receive an update on the value-based insurance design PERS
Select plan and additional presentations on mental health from Anthem Blue Cross, Blue
Shield of California and UnitedHealthcare.
