## **Executive Summary**

This agenda item presents the California Public Employees' Retirement System (CalPERS) Health Benefits Program Annual Report for the 2019 health plan year. This report provides the California Legislature and Director of Finance with information about the CalPERS Health Benefits Program, pursuant to California Government Code Section 22866.

## Background

The 2015 state budget act enhanced annual reporting requirements for the CalPERS Health Benefits Program. We transmitted our first Health Benefits Program Annual Report to the California Legislature and Director of Finance on November 1, 2016 and continue to meet the statutory deadline every year thereafter.

## Analysis

The report, available on the CalPERS website, offers a comprehensive view of the Health Benefits Program. The Health team collaborates with several program areas across the organization to collect and present information about our health plans, program administration, and financials. The report contains, but is not limited to, the following:

- Historic enrollment and expenditure data for Basic and Medicare health plans
