30% ■ Document internal controls by mapping program level cross-functional processes.

25% ■ Implement Operational Risk Event Reporting: Phase III.

Enhance compliance and risk functions throughout the enterprise.
30% ■ Educate CalPERS team members and stakeholders to continue to cultivate a risk-intelligent organization through the implementation of the ERMD Communication Plan.

20% ■ Enhance enterprise data governance to ensure accuracy, consistency, and strengthen data-driven decisions.

10% ■ Complete 2019 State Leadership Accountability Act (SLAA) Report Implementation Plan updates.

Evaluate CalPERS' insurance portfolio to verify adequate coverage exists for current risk transfer strategies.
