I have received the Board's decision based on the appeal hearing. I do not agree and would like to petition you to reconsider. Dr. Williams did not administer any kind of test or exam that could possibly show that I am now fit for duty. Flexion, extension and rotation are all he examined. I have chronic shoulder pain and weakness. I have been to the doctor for my shoulder injury but the solution is always pain medication. My shoulder is not better by any means and I do not believe I am capable of performing all of my job duties. Furthermore, I don't believe I can defend myself if needed, which is terrifying and extremely stressful. A portion of my disability rating percentage was for depression and anxiety. I was never reevaluated for that. It feels very much like I am being pushed back into a place that is not safe. Your letter says I have 30 days to petition for reconsideration but I received the decision by mail on March 16th, today is March 21st, that is most definitely not 30 days. I don't even understand how that is legal. You issue this decision and require my petition for reconsideration prior to when it is actually due, a mere 5 days after receiving your decision.
