	Issues/Status:	This putative class action against CaIPERS, the State, and over 1000 CaIPERS employers alleges that the PERL's formula for paying disability retirement benefits discriminates against workers who were hired at age 41 and above and then retired on disability as compared to workers hired at age 40 and below. The suit asserts causes of action for age discrimination, breach of contract, and equal protection. The proposed plaintiff class is all members who were first hired by CaIPERS-covered agencies when they were 41 or older and who were granted disability retirement. The proposed defendant class is CaIPERS, the State, and all CaIPERS-covered agencies who employed members in the plaintiff class. The lawsuit seeks enhanced retirement benefits, compensatory damages, interest, fees and costs, and declaratory relief.
