KAI ON: Okay. Good morning, Board members. I was here last time about Cal -- my fake CalPERS retirement payment and impersonated CalPERS emails. After the last meeting, CalPERS staff didn't confirm and verify if my retirement is fake or not.

They also did not confirm and verify if State Controller's Office had ever report any -- my contribution to CalPERS after 2014. When I retired -- I filed retirement two years ago, CalPERS did not advise me how can I get back my health insurance. CalPERS did not advise me to join California Retiree -- State Retirees union, and CalPERS did not advise me to enroll to group legal insurance at Department of Human Resources.

Ms. Ortega, last year, I went to Department of Human Resources asked for help. They didn't respond.

Also, Ms. Kristi Griffiths had never show up to clarify the impersonated email and why she stopped responding to me two years ago after I request her to meet at State Controller office to reconcile our payroll history.

Another issue is I have been CalPERS six times since last Board meeting. CalPERS staff have never helped me to make appointment to talk with Ms. Taylor. It just somebody tried to stop me to talk to somebody to the Board member. Ms. Taylor, I'm begging you if you can invite

State Auditor's Office, Mr. Michael Tilden to your office so we can meet together, so I can submit my documents for State Auditor Office to contact investigation.

Can I ask the staff to make sure that they respond to Mr. On, if they haven't already. I appreciate it.
