Subject: Reciprocal Agreement Established — City of Delano Employee Pension Plan

#### **Purpose**

The purpose of this Circular Letter is to inform you that the City of Delano Employee Pension Plan has entered into a reciprocity agreement with the California Public Employees' Retirement System (CalPERS) as of October 8, 2022.

#### **Impacts**

Your employees who have worked for the City of Delano and are currently members of CalPERS may be eligible for reciprocal benefits.

## Where to Direct Employee Requests

Members may submit a request to establish reciprocity as follows:

- 1. Log in to myCalPERS.
- 2. Select the **Retirement** tab.
- 3. Select **Retirement Summary** from the drop-down list.
- 4. In the Reciprocity section, select **submit a request to establish a reciprocity** link.

Once the request is submitted, we'll send the member a letter confirming receipt of their authorized request to establish reciprocity. Members can view their online requests in myCalPERS to monitor the determination status.
