No paper copy is required. \$5,000 reports are only required to be filed by candidate controlled committees. |
| Within 10 Days <i>Independent Expenditure Verification</i> | Ongoing | 462 | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Committees making independent expenditures must file this form with the FPPC—E-mail only, no paper copy is required. Committees file only one Form 462 per election for each candidate supported or opposed by an independent expenditure. |
| Within 24 Hours <i>Election Cycle Reports</i> | 7/2/19 – 9/30/19 9/10/19– 12/9/19 <i>(for runoff)</i> | 496 497 | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> E-File only – no paper copy. 496: Primarily formed committees file if independent expenditures totaling \$1,000 or more are <i>made</i>. Candidates: Do not file for expenditures made on your own committee’s behalf. 497: File if contributions totaling \$1,000 or more are <i>received</i> from a single source. 497: File if contributions totaling \$1,000 or more are <i>made</i> to a candidate listed on the ballot. The recipient of a non-monetary contribution must file a Form 497 within 48 hours from the time the contribution is <i>received</i>. |
| Jul 31, 2019 <i>Semi-Annual</i> | 1/1/19 – 6/30/19 | 460 | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 460: Paper filing and online for E-filers. |
| Aug 28, 2019 <i>1st Pre-Election</i> | 7/1/19 – 8/25/19 | 460 or 470 | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Each candidate listed on the ballot must file Form 460 or Form 470 (see notes below). 460: Paper filing and online for E-filers. |
| Sep 30, 2019 <i>2nd Pre-Election</i> | 8/26/19 – 9/25/19 | 460 | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 460: Paper filing and online for E-filers. Paper filings must be sent by personal delivery or guaranteed overnight service only. The September 28 filing deadline falls on a weekend/holiday, so the deadline is extended to the next business day. |
| Dec 9, 2019 <i>Pre-Election (Runoff)</i> | 9/26/19 – 12/4/19 | 460 | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 460: Paper filing and online for E-filers. Paper filings must be sent by personal delivery or guaranteed overnight service only. The December 7 filing deadline falls on a weekend/holiday, so the deadline is extended to the next business day. |

Additional Notes:

- **E-File:** A state committee that has received contributions or made expenditures totaling \$25,000 or more.
- **Form 460:** All state committees, including e-filers, must file paper reports with the Secretary of State. A copy must also be e-mailed to CalPERS at Board_Election_Coordinator@calpers.ca.gov.
- **Form 460:** Candidates who have raised/spent \$2,000 or more file the Form 460. The Form 410 (Statement of Organization) must also be filed once \$2,000 or more has been raised/spent.
- **Form 470:** Candidates who do not have an open committee and do not raise or spend \$2,000 may file Form 470 on or before August 28, 2019. If, later during the calendar year, a campaign committee must be opened, a Form 470 Supplement and a Form 410 must be filed.
- **Forms 496 and 497:** All reports filed online only with the Secretary of State and e-mailed to CalPERS at Board_Election_Coordinator@calpers.ca.gov.
- **Multiple Candidate Controlled Committees:** All committees controlled by a CalPERS candidate must file statements on each filing deadline, in addition to the committee formed for this election.
- **Filing Deadlines:** Deadlines are extended when they fall on a Saturday, Sunday, or an official state holiday. This extension does not apply to any 24-hour/10-day independent expenditure reports (Form 496) or to 24-hour/10-day contribution reports (Form 497) that are due the weekend before the election. Such reports must be filed within 24 hours regardless of the day of the week. A \$10 per day late fine may be assessed on both the paper and electronic report resulting in a \$20 per day fine.
- **Period Covered:** The period covered by any statement begins on the day after the closing date of the last statement filed, or January 1, if no previous statement has been filed.
- **Contribution Limits:** Contributions to CalPERS candidates are subject to contribution limits of \$4,700 per election. Committees that make contributions to CalPERS candidates are subject to contribution limits of \$7,800 per calendar year.
- **Public Documents:** All forms are public documents. Campaign manuals and instructional materials available at www.fppc.ca.gov, click on the [Campaign Rules](#) link.
- **Voting Periods:** Begin August 30, 2019 and November 8, 2019.
- **Section 84200.9** sets pre-election deadlines.
