

## CALPERS HEALTH BENEFITS PROGRAM ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSES CONSOLIDATION

### Introduction

The Governor and Legislature must approve the use of the funds deposited into the Public Employees' Contingency Reserve Fund (CRF) and Health Care Fund (HCF) for the California Public Employees' Retirement System's (CalPERS) Health Benefits Program's administrative expenses in the annual Budget Act.

Pursuant to Control Section 4.20(b) in the 2017-18 Budget Act, the CalPERS Board of Administration is required to report to the Legislative budget committee of each house on the fiscal effect to the state, and different local government employers and employees, if all health benefit administrative costs were paid from the CRF and no administrative costs were paid through health premiums deposited in the HCF.

### Summary

The total 2017-18 premiums for the CalPERS Health Benefits Program are approximately \$9.1 billion. The Health Benefits Program has an authorized budget amount of approximately \$73 million attributable to its administrative expenses for fiscal year 2017-18.

- \$30 million of this amount is received from a fee charged directly to employers (state and contracting public agencies) and is deposited into the CRF.
- \$43 million is received through self-funded and flex-funded health benefit plan premiums and deposited into the HCF. On average, the state as an employer pays 85 percent of these premiums, with employees paying the remaining 15 percent. In aggregate, public agency employers pay approximately 31 percent of these premiums, with employees paying the remaining 69 percent.

Consolidating health administrative expenses would eliminate the need to build HCF administrative expenses into flex-funded and self-funded health premiums. This could also simplify fiscal oversight by the various Control Agencies. Although shifting administrative expense from the HCF (employer/employee based) to the CRF (employer based only) would not increase the total administrative health program, there would be a fiscal impact to the state and public agencies currently contributing administrative fees to CalPERS.

Employees enrolled in flex-funded and self-funded health benefit plans would no longer contribute a portion of their income to support the Health Benefits Program's administrative expenses, leaving employers with sole responsibility for these expenses. This cost would vary depending on employer size and the employer/employee cost share percentage for health care coverage contributions.

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### Analysis

The payment of administrative costs only from the CRF would not eliminate the HCF. The HCF would continue to be used to pay for external costs such as third-party administrator fees and benefit payments that CalPERS incurs for self-funded and flex-funded health plans.

Moving \$43 million from the HCF to the CRF would not increase the total cost of administering the program. The exact fiscal impact for the state and individual public agency employers would depend on the amount of the employer/employee cost sharing relationship. The employee share varies, as it depends on collective bargaining agreements and vesting requirements related to retired employees receiving employer-paid health benefits.

Full reporting of public agency employer/employee cost sharing is not available to CalPERS. Only a minimum employer contribution is required through the Public Employees' Medical & Hospital Care Act (PEMHCA), which governs the CalPERS Health Benefits Program. These minimums make up the aggregated public agency employer contributions estimate of 31 percent and corresponding employee contributions estimate of 69 percent. Any subsequent employer contributions to public agency employees due to collective bargaining agreements do not require disclosure to CalPERS.

Premiums for all CalPERS health plans would be impacted by this change, excluding fully-insured plans; Kaiser Permanente and United Healthcare Medicare. Impacted plans would include flex-funded plans provided by Anthem Blue Cross, Blue Shield of California, Health Net of California, Sharp Health Plan, United Healthcare (non-Medicare), and Western Health Advantage, as well as self-funded plans administered by Anthem Blue Cross including PERS Care, PERS Choice, and PERS Select.

While the State of California is one employer, there are 1,147 individual public agency employers. The individual fiscal impact on these employers would depend on how many of their employees are covered by fully-insured plans (Kaiser Permanente and United Healthcare Medicare) versus flex-funded or self-funded plans that have the administrative expenses built into their premiums. Higher participation in fully-insured plans would have a higher fiscal impact to employers because there would be no corresponding deductions in premiums to help offset an employer's increase in cost. All employers share the cost to administer the Health Benefits Program equally, regardless of how many participants they have in the program.

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Annual savings due to removing HCF administrative expenses from premiums for employees and retirees are estimated to be \$8 per premium for the state and \$39 per premium for public agencies. Total estimated employee savings would be \$2.3 million for state employees and \$13.2 million for public agencies' for a total savings of \$15.5 million. The table below reflects the corresponding anticipated cost increases for the state and public agency employers.

The CRF Current column in the chart below reflects the annual amount employers are paying through a direct billing process, the CRF Proposed Increase column reflects how much the amount paid through the direct billing process would increase if all costs were paid through the CRF process, and the CRF Proposed Total column is the total of these two amounts. The HCF Current column reflects the annual amount paid by the employer for administrative expenses through health premiums. The Estimated Annual Increase column reflects the CRF Proposed Total amount reduced by the amount in the HCF Current column.

The table on the next page reflects the average annual fiscal impact to public agency employers and employees if the Health Benefits Program's administrative expenses were paid solely from the CRF. The data is stratified so public agency employers with a similar number of individuals participating in the health program are grouped together.

The Number of Public Agencies column shows how many public agency employers provide health benefits for the corresponding range in the Total Covered Lives column. The Net Administrative Fee Increase Per Public Agency column is the average increase for all public agency employers in that level of stratification, similar to the Net Administrative Fee Savings Per Public Agency column which reflects the estimated savings due to removing HCF administrative expenses from premiums for all public agency employers in that level of stratification. The Increase Per Employee column shows there would be no increase in administrative fees paid by the employees, and in fact, the Savings Per Employee column notes there will be approximately \$39 in annual savings per employee.

### Considerations

Existing law (Government Code Section 22910) allows for the Health Benefits Program’s administrative expenses to be deposited into and paid from the CRF. Technical statutory amendments to Government Code Section 22910, 22911 and related statutes would be necessary to effectuate a change to the current way of collecting administrative expenses.

### Outcomes

Moving to an employer-only administrative fee contribution model would have an estimated fiscal impact to the state of approximately \$2.3 million annually. This amount is relatively low because the state already pays 85 percent of total health premiums. The larger impact would be to public agency employers, who would experience an estimated overall cost increase of \$13.2 million annually.

Consolidating and streamlining the Health Benefits Program’s administrative expenses currently paid from the CRF and HCF into only the CRF could provide the following benefits:

- Slightly lessen the operational complexity of the program because administrative expenses would no longer need to be built into flex-funded and self-funded premiums
- Simplify Control Agency monitoring
- Slight savings for employees

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However, moving to an employer-only contribution model may produce the following unintentional negative consequences to the CalPERS Health Benefits Program:

- Could lose competitive advantage over brokers that compete with CalPERS in the health benefits coverage marketplace due to increased public agency costs
- If public agencies leave the CalPERS Health Benefits Program because of these increased costs, CalPERS risks losing its market influence and ability to mitigate health plan premium increases as it would have a smaller risk pool
- Employers could be in less of a position to negotiate with labor groups due to these increased costs
- There is no new added value to employers for the increase in costs

## Impact Analysis - Summary

This workbook provides information regarding the fiscal effect on the State and public agency employers if all of CalPERS Health Benefits Program’s administrative expenses were assessed on employers and paid from the Public Employees’ Contingency Reserve Fund (CRF) instead of being partially funded through health plan premiums and paid from the Public Employees’ Health Care Fund (HCF).

### Budget and Fiscal Impacts

Moving to an employer-only administrative fee contribution model would have moderate to significant financial impacts on the State and public agencies. The State would see an administrative cost increase of approximately \$25.5 million annually, and public agencies would experience an overall administrative cost increase of approximately \$18.7 million annually. On average, the administrative fees assessment on public agency employers is estimated to increase approximately one hundred and fifty percent (150%).

### Analysis

Below is an overview of the methodology and assumptions used to determine the fiscal effect on the State and different local government employers and employees, if all the Health Benefits Program’s administrative expenses were paid through the CRF, and not partially through self-funded and flex-funded health benefit plan premiums.

- As the number of total covered lives (TCLs) and gross health insurance premiums regularly fluctuate, data from October 2017 was used to develop both monthly and annual impacts.
- The current administrative cost billed to employers was calculated at 0.32 percent.
  - Each fiscal year, CalPERS collaborates with DOF to set the CRF Administrative Fee. The fee for FY 2017-18 is 0.33 percent, and was 0.31 percent for FY 2016-17, therefore the average of those two FYs was used for this exercise. This fee is applied to the gross health insurance premiums paid by the employer.
- Administrative expenses built into health plan premiums on a per member per month (PMPM) basis were removed from the gross health insurance premiums for each employer.
  - By removing the PMPM fees, a reduction in the gross health insurance premiums for each employer can be shown. The PMPM fees assessed for 2017 was \$4.68 for TCLs enrolled in all plans except Kaiser and UnitedHealthcare Medicare, which did not include the PMPM fee in 2017.
- A CRF administrative fee of 0.82 percent was applied to the revised gross health insurance premiums, as this is the percentage required to collect the authorized amount of money appropriated for administrative expenses for the CalPERS Health Program.
- To determine the net annual impact, we removed previous employer payments to the CRF and HCF, then calculated the new expenses. This results in a \$13.2M (75%) annual increase for public agencies, and a \$2.3M (6%) annual increase for the State.
