

A Guide to Understanding Your Health Plan Statement

This year's Health Plan Statement contains new features to provide customized health enrollment information, which will enable members to make informed decisions about their health plan options.

- 1 As of Date**
Provides your health enrollment information as of the date indicated. Any health enrollment changes processed on or after this date will not be reflected.
- 2 Custom Messages**
Informs you of specific health benefit changes that may impact you in the upcoming year.
- 3 Current Health Plan**
Provides the name of your enrolled health plan.
- 4 ZIP Code Eligibility**
Provides your eligibility ZIP code.
- 5 Current Enrollment**
Lists you and your enrolled family members.
- 6 Notice of Privacy Practices**
This notice informs you of your privacy rights regarding the medical information CalPERS has on file about you.
- 7 2016 Monthly Premium Rate**
Provides your 2016 monthly premium rate.
- 8 2017 Monthly Premium Rate**
Provides your 2017 Monthly Premium Rate if you do not change your health plan.
- 9 2017 Health Plans Available**
Provides the 2017 health plans and monthly premium rates that may be available in your eligibility ZIP code.

If you are a working retiree, you may use the ZIP Code of your current employer for health plan eligibility. If you are a retiree, you may only use your residential address to establish eligibility.
