**NOTICE OF MODIFICATIONS TO TEXT OF  
PROPOSED REGULATION**

Pursuant to the requirements of Government Code Section 11346.8 (c), and section 44 Title 1 of the California Code of Regulations, the California Public Employees' Retirement System (CalPERS) Board of Administration is providing notice of changes made to proposed regulation Title 2, Section 559.500, Article 1 of Chapter 2 of Division 1 of Title 2 of the California Code of Regulations (CCR). These changes are in response to direction received from the Office of Administrative Law (OAL) regarding the proposed regulation, the Affidavit of Parent-Child Relationship (Affidavit) and the Addendum to the Initial Statement of Reasons (Addendum). As a result of these comments, CalPERS is properly incorporating the Affidavit by specific reference in the regulatory text, identifying the form by name and revision date; and revising both the regulatory text and Affidavit language so they mirror one another. Minor clarifying changes were also made to the Addendum.
