

A Guide to Understanding Your Health Plan Statement

Your Health Plan Statement provides customized health enrollment information, which will enable you to explore, learn, and decide on your health plan options.

- 1 As of Date**
Provides your health enrollment information as of the date indicated. Any health enrollment changes processed on or after this date will not be reflected.
- 2 Custom Messages**
Informs you of specific health benefit changes that may impact you in the upcoming year.
- 3 Current Health Plan**
Provides the name of your enrolled health plan.
- 4 ZIP Code Eligibility**
Provides your eligibility ZIP code.
- 5 Current Enrollment**
Lists you and your enrolled family members.
- 6 Notice of Privacy Practices**
This notice informs you of your privacy rights regarding the medical information CalPERS has on file about you.
- 7 2017 Monthly Premium Rate**
Provides your 2017 monthly premium rate.
- 8 2018 Monthly Premium Rate**
Provides your 2018 monthly premium rate if you do not change your health plan.
- 9 2018 Health Plans Available**
Provides the 2018 health plans and monthly premium rates that may be available in your eligibility ZIP code.

If you are a working retiree, you may use the ZIP code of your current employer for health plan eligibility. If you are a retiree, you may only use your residential address to establish eligibility. You can obtain a list of available health plans based on eligibility ZIP codes from the CalPERS website at www.calpers.ca.gov, by contacting CalPERS at 888 CalPERS (or 888-225-7377), or if active, by contacting your Health Benefits Officer or Human Resources Department.
