And first order of business is roll call, please. 4 COMMITTEE SECRETARY QUERAL: Theresa Taylor? 5 CHAIRPERSON TAYLOR: Here. 6 COMMITTEE SECRETARY QUERAL: 7 Eraina Ortega? 8 VICE CHAIRPERSON ORTEGA: Here. 9 COMMITTEE SECRETARY QUERAL: Margaret Brown? COMMITTEE MEMBER BROWN: Here. 10 COMMITTEE SECRETARY OUERAL: Rob Feckner? 11 COMMITTEE MEMBER FECKNER: Good morning. 12 COMMITTEE SECRETARY OUERAL: Lisa Middleton? 13 COMMITTEE MEMBER MIDDLETON: Present. 14 COMMITTEE SECRETARY QUERAL: Stacie Olivares? 15 16 COMMITTEE MEMBER OLIVARES: Here. 9 DEPUTY EXECUTIVE OFFICER HOFFNER: Thank you, Mr. 10 Chair. I want to congratulate both you and the Vice Chair 11 for the election earlier today. I also want to welcome 12 Ms. Westly to the Committee as well. It's a pleasure to 13 meet you.

We have two items today before the Committee, both action items. One is the approval of the CEO's semiannual report, and the second is the review and approval of the delegation of the Committee.

In addition, I want to provide a quick update to the request for proposal for the Board's executive incentive comp consultant. The Committee took action on that in September, and we're in the process of having the RFP go out the door in early March. And we'll come back as the subcommittee meets to evaluate those proposals in -- later this year.

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I'd also like to highlight the fact that since we

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were last here together, we have filled the Chief -- Human 1 Resource Division Chief role here at CalPERS. So I want 2 to announce that she's -- Michelle Tucker will be the new 3 HR chief. She's not with us today. She starts on March 4 2nd. And with that, I'd also like to thank Renee Salazar, 5 who's been the Interim HR Chief. She's done a fantastic 6 job. And she will carry us through the rest of this 7 Committee today, but I do appreciate her leadership in 8 that role for the last few months. 9 So with that, that will conclude my opening 10 remarks and we can move on to the action items. 11 CHAIRPERSON FECKNER: Excellent. Thank you very 12 much. So thank you, Ms. Salazar. 13 Brings us to Agenda Item 6, action consent 14 calendar, approval of the Performance, Compensation 15 16 meeting minutes. What's the pleasure of the Committee? 17 Somebody has to move it. 18 COMMITTEE MEMBER BROWN: I wasn't on the 19 Committee. 20 COMMITTEE MEMBER MIDDLETON: I'll move it. 21 CHAIRPERSON FECKNER: Moved by Ms. Middleton. 2.2 23 Seconded by? COMMITTEE MEMBER OLIVARES: Second. 24 25 CHAIRPERSON FECKNER: Seconded by Ms. Olivares.

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Any discussion on the motion? 1 Seeing none. 2 All in favor say aye? 3 (Ayes.) 4 CHAIRPERSON FECKNER: Opposed, no? 5 Motion carries. 6 What was that? 7 8 COMMITTEE MEMBER BROWN: Abstain. 9 CHAIRPERSON FECKNER: Show Ms. Brown as abstaining. 10 And just for clarification, the reason why there 11 was a little bit of hesitation up here, some of these 12 members weren't on the Committee when we had the ast 13 meeting, so they didn't feel they could make motions or 14 vote. So that's why it was a little cumbersome. 15 It won't 16 be that way next month. CHAIRPERSON FECKNER: Move on to Item 7, 17 information consent items. 18 Item 7a, annual calendar review. 19 Mr. Hoffner. 20 DEPUTY EXECUTIVE OFFICER HOFFNER: Nothing to 21 report on the annual calendar. 2.2 23 CHAIRPERSON FECKNER: All right. Ms. Brown. 24 25 COMMITTEE MEMBER BROWN: Thank you, Mr. Chair,

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1 and congratulations.

2 CHAIRPERSON FECKNER: Thank you. COMMITTEE MEMBER BROWN: I just wanted to say 3 that -- let the rest of the Committee know that I had sent 4 an email to Doug Hoffner with the new calendar saying 5 could I take a look at the -- last year's calendar and the 6 calendar before, since we've changed the number of 7 8 meetings. I just wanted to make sure all the items were covered. And you forwarded that and it was very help 9 physical. I appreciate that. Thank you. 10 CHAIRPERSON FECKNER: Great. 11 Thank you. 12 Seeing nothing -- no requests on the draft agenda for April 20th, moving on to Item 8, action agenda items. 13 8a, the semiannual status report of the incentive 14 plan of the CEO. Ms. Salazar. 15 16 HUMAN RESOURCES DIVISION INTERIM CHIEF SALAZAR: Good afternoon, Mr. Chair and members of the 17 Renee Salazar, CalPERS team member. Committee. 18 As discussed earlier in closed session, the 19 Executive Compensation Policy requires the CEO to prepare 20 a semiannual status report on their incentive plan for the 21 Performance, Compensation and Talent Management 2.2 23 Committee's review and approval. The proposed report is to inform the Committee on progress toward achieving the 24 25 plan's measures.

Presented in Attachment 1 is the CEO's semiannual status report, which covers the time period of July 1st through December 31st, 2019. Thank you. That concludes my report.

5 Although, Ms. Frost is here to -- in case you 6 have questions about the report.

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CHAIRPERSON FECKNER: Very good. Thank you. Any requests or questions from the Committee? Seeing none.

HUMAN RESOURCES DIVISION INTERIM CHIEF SALAZAR:

The delegation resolution for the Performance, 17 Compensation and Talent Management Committee is reviewed 18 on an annual basis. Team members have reviewed the 19 20 Committee delegation and recommend revisions to simplify the language, and formatting, and alignment with other 21 committee delegations. If the Committee wishes to make 2.2 23 additional revisions to the delegation resolution, they will be incorporated and bought back for Board 24 25 consideration for approval in April 2020.

Is there 14 anyone out there that wishes to address the committee at 15 this time? 16 Mr. Johnson is shaking his head no. That's a 17 good sign too. 18 19 (Laughter.) 20 CHAIRPERSON FECKNER: Thank you, Neal. All right.
