Mr. Jarzombek, Chief, HPRA, provided the PHBC with an update on the PPO transition to a new Third-Party Administrator (TPA), Blue Shield of California, and CalPERS' first population health management vendor, Included Health, effective January 1, 2025.

Agenda Item 7c – Retiree Cost-of-Living Adjustment 2025

Kimberlee Pulido, Division Chief, Retirement Benefit Services Division (RBSD), provided the annual rate of inflation as measured by the percentage change in the CPI-U was 4.12%. The impact of the 4.12% inflation for the Cost-of-Living-Adjustment (COLA) is reflected in provided charts by COLA provision and year of retirement.

Agenda Item 7d – Summary of Committee Direction

Mr. Moulds provided a summary of the Committee direction from the March 19, 2025, meeting. The Committee directed staff as follows:

- Continue looking for more affordable out-of-state options including but not limited to changes in statute and continued conversations with CalHR and report back to the Board in June.
- Report back at the June board meeting or when appropriate with clinical quality metrics for PPO members who transitioned to Blue Shield and Included Health.
