From 2021-2024, he was ranked the #1 researcher in Sustainability Research by the Institutional Investor Survey in the US, during which time he was also top ranked in Thematic Research. He was also #1 ranked researcher in Japan and #3 in Europe, according to the same survey. During this period, Aniket was one of the top ranked Equity Strategists on Wall Street.

Aniket serves on the Board of Directors of the UN Sustainable Development Solutions Network and on the President's Advisory Council at the Woodwell Climate Research Center. He previously served as the Chairman of the Board of Amnesty International USA. He is a Full Member of the Economic Club of New York and the Bretton Woods Committee.

Aniket received his BA in Political Science from Yale University and PhD in Economic Geography from the University of Oxford. He received many prestigious awards and scholarships during his academic studies.
