

Health Plan Spotlight: Sutter Health Plan

Overview

Sutter Health Plan is the health insurance arm of Sutter Health, one of California's largest not-for-profit integrated health care delivery systems. The plan was originally launched in 2014 as Sutter Health Plus to provide affordable coordinated health coverage linked directly to Sutter Health's network of physicians, hospitals, and outpatient facilities. On January 1, 2025, the organization officially rebranded as Sutter Health Plan to better reflect its role as an integral part of the Sutter Health family while maintaining the same legal entity and health plan operations.

As part of the broader Sutter Health System, Sutter Health Plan is designed around an integrated care model that aligns insurance coverage with health care delivery. The plan works in close partnership with Sutter physicians, medical groups, hospitals, urgent care centers, and specialty providers. This alignment is intended to improve care coordination, simplify navigation of the healthcare system, reduce unnecessary duplication of services, and support better clinical outcomes while managing costs. In 2026, the plan serves more than 120,000 members across Northern California.
