We know you work hard to take care of your loved ones and we want to make sure you can provide for them in the event of your passing. That's why it's important to designate your beneficiaries so they can continue to receive your benefits, ranging from a single lump sum to a monthly allowance.

If you don't designate a beneficiary, then benefits are paid to your survivors in an order defined by law, beginning with your Spouse or Registered Domestic Partner.

By designating a beneficiary ahead of time, you can determine exactly who will receive your CalPERS death benefits. You may name as your beneficiary any person, a corporation, or your estate.
