Purpose of the Funded Ratio Scatterplot

The purpose of the funded ratio scatterplot is to allow stakeholders to see how the CalPERS pension plans maintained by different public agencies compare to one another.


The tool allows you to:

- Filter the data by classification (Miscellaneous or Safety), agency type, and/or county
- Highlight one or more agencies
- Hover over any data point to see more detail, such as the Unfunded Accrued Liability (UAL).
- Toggle between viewing a scatterplot of funded ratios on a plan or an agency basis
- Select any data point and active a button to navigate to the plan dashboard.


For a better user experience, view the tool on a desktop/laptop rather than a mobile device.

Viewing Funded Ratios


When the page loads, one data point will be shown for every Miscellaneous plan as well as every Safety plan. If an agency receives separate valuation reports for different Safety categories, such as Police and Fire, there will be one data point for each. The default display will be on a "plan basis" where each data point represents **a single plan**.




Use the **Filters** on the left to focus on the peer group of interest based on **Classification**, **Agency Type** and **County**.




For example, to view only Miscellaneous plans for cities and towns in Los Angeles County, begin by checking the Miscellaneous filter under **Classification**.




Check the City and Town filter under Agency Type.




Open the **County** drop down list, check the Los Angeles filter and close the drop-down list.




To highlight specific agencies, open the **Highlight Agency** drop down list, check one or more agencies and close the drop-down list. The highlighted data points will appear in orange.




Hover the mouse over any data point for more information.



To view results on an "agency basis" where each data point represents a **single agency's** plans on an aggregated basis, check the **Agency Basis** toggle and hover the mouse over a data point.



To clear filters, click the eraser above each filter.



Purpose of the Plan Dashboard

The purpose of the Plan Dashboard tool is to allow stakeholders to see information about a specific CalPERS pension plan.

The tool allows you to view the following information for a selected plan:

- Employer Normal cost rate
- Member contribution rate
- Funded status
- Member count
- Projected UAL payment


It also provides details via the following graphs:

- Funded ratio history the plan's history is compared to the funded ratio history for all public agency plans.
- Funded status history the plan's accrued liability is displayed alongside the plan's assets and surplus or UAL.
- UAL payments by Fiscal Year the plan's UAL payments for each year, broken out into required payments and any Additional Discretionary Payments (ADP).

For a better user experience, view the tool on a desktop or laptop rather than a mobile device.

Navigating to the Plan Dashboard


To navigate to the Plan Dashboard, open the **Funded Ratio Scatterplot**, ensure you are viewing it on the Plan Basis, select a plan to view, and click on **Plan Dashboard**.





To view more information in charts, hover your mouse over a specific year.




To view any of the tables or charts in **full size**, click on the **Focus Mode** button, located at the top right of each table or chart.




Viewing the Plan Dashboard (continued)

To return to the Dashboard, click on **Back to Report** on the top left.




Navigating from the Plan Dashboard

This dashboard's **navigation buttons** are located on the top right side.





The purpose of the Agency Dashboard tool is to allow stakeholders to see information about all the agency's CalPERS pension plan.

The tool allows you to view the following information for an agency:

- ♦ All CalPERS pension plans
- ♦ Employer Normal cost rate for all plans
- ♦ Member contribution rate for all plans


It also provides details via the following graphs:

- ◆ Funded ratio history the agency's history is compared to the funded ratio history for all public agencies.
- ◆ Funded status history the agency's accrued liability is displayed alongside the agency's assets and surplus or UAL.
- ◆ UAL payments by Fiscal Year the agency's UAL payments for each year, broken out into required payments and any ADPs.





To view more information in charts, hover your mouse over a specific year.




To view any of the tables or charts in full size, click on the Focus Mode button, located at the top right of each table or chart.



Navigating from the Agency Dashboard

This dashboard's **navigation buttons** are located on the top left side. Note that the Plan Dashboard button will be greyed out unless a plan is selected in the Plans box.



To go on to the **Plan Dashboard**, select the desired plan from the **Plans** box, then click on the orange **Plan Dashboard** button.




Navigating from the Agency Dashboard (continued)

Alternatively, **right click** on the desired rate plan in the Plans box, select Drill through from the dropdown menu, and click on **Plan Dashboard**.
