January 1st of the


following year

Basic & Medicare Plans — Health Plan Changes for 2025

Benefit	Changes
Doula Benefit for all Pregnant and Postpartum Members	New benefit for all pregnant and postpartum Basic plan members to receive health education, advocacy, physical and emotional non-medical support before, during and after pregnancy, miscarriage, stillbirth, and abortions.
Travel Benefit for Medically Necessary Care	Standardize travel and lodging coverage for eligible medically necessary services including, but not limited to abortion services, gender affirming care, complex surgeries, and cancer care that cannot be accessed within 50 miles from the member's residence for all Basic and Medicare plan members, up to \$5,000 per occurrence.
