In advance of the 2023 Health Open Enrollment period, we want to inform you of key changes to your current health plan. Effective January 1, 2024, Health Net SmartCare will no longer be available in your area.

Open Enrollment is September 18 – October 13, 2023. Unless you make a health plan change during Open Enrollment, you and any dependent(s) will be automatically enrolled in Blue Shield Access+, effective January 1, 2024, which has the best network overlap.

We encourage you to shop health plans. We offer a variety of plans with quality health care provider networks; however, **no action is required if you wish to enroll in Blue Shield Access+**.

Regardless of the health plan you enroll in, continuity of care coverage is available to you even if your current doctor, medical group, or hospital is not available. This means you will continue to receive the medical and behavioral health services and medicines you need. Check with your health plan or call the Department of Managed Health Care at 1-888-466-2219 for more information about continuity of care options.

We'd also like to inform you of health plan expansions that may be available in your area for 2024. The expansions include combination plans.

UnitedHealthcare SignatureValue Alliance will be expanding into 12 counties for public agency and school members: Alameda, Contra Costa, Marin, Merced, San Francisco, San Joaquin, San Mateo, Santa Clara, Santa Cruz, Solano, Sonoma, and Stanislaus.

UnitedHealthcare SignatureValue Harmony will be expanding into 2 counties: Santa Clara and Santa Cruz.

Beginning September 11, 2023, you can access your customized Open Enrollment information, tools, and resources online at my.calpers.ca.gov.

When shopping for health plans, consider lower cost options, available doctors and hospitals, and the location of care facilities. We want you to be well-informed so you can make the best decision for you and your family.

See how much you could save by switching plans. On September 11, log in to your myCalPERS account at my.calpers.ca.gov. Use the **Search Health Plans** tool to:

- Find and compare 2024 health plans available in your area
- See monthly premiums and member satisfaction ratings
- View side-by-side health plan, benefit, and copay comparisons
- Check which plans your doctor or medical group is available in. You may be able to switch to a lower-cost plan and still keep your doctor or medical group

If you'd like to change your health plan during Open Enrollment, log in to your myCalPERS account at my.calpers.ca.gov. Check with your employer to confirm their participation in online enrollments.
